Several thousand copies will be printed & distributed throughout St. Lawrence County.



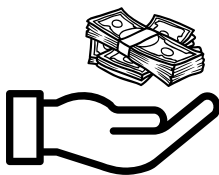

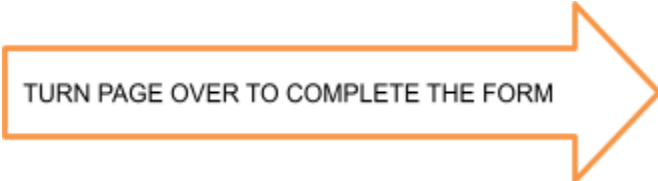
